Observation of World Environment Day :A Report

The Environment and Climate Cell of Kamrup College, Chamata has been observing World Environment Day each year on 5th June to raise awareness among the local people and students of schools and colleges and to take positive environmental action to protect the planet Earth and nature.

In this year also Environment and Climate Cell of Kamrup College, Chamata has successfully organized a host of activities on the occasion of World Environment Day.2022. These activities are:

- 1. An essay competition was organised among the students of the college on the theme "Sustainable Development and Environment -friendly Living" one week ahead of the WED. Fifteen no. of students participated in this competition and three best participants were awarded for their quality write up.
- 2. On 5th June an awareness meeting was held in the college premise in which Dr. Saiki Talukdar, HoD of Political Science delivered a speech on the theme "Only one Earth".
- 3. The awareness meeting was followed by a plantation drive was organised by the cell. Nearly 25 saplings were planted with protection net in the roadside near the college.


