


The Department of Zoology at Kamrup College, Chamata, successfully hosted its inaugural talk as part of the **1st Annual Lecture Series**, engaging students and science enthusiasts. The event took place on November 22, 2023, from 10:00 am to 11:30 am.

This year, the department extended an invitation to **Ms. Trisha Kundu**, a PhD Candidate at the Institute of Integrative Cell Biology and Physiology, University of Münster, Germany, and Cells in Motion-International Max Planck Research School (CiM-IMPRS), Germany. Ms. Kundu delivered a captivating lecture titled "**How do neurons polarize?**"

The event commenced with a warm welcome and an introduction to the speaker by Nipu Kumar Das, Assistant Professor and Head of the Department of Zoology at KCC. Ms. Kundu then delved into her enlightening discussion on neuron physiology, the role of organelles within neurons, showcased live neuron videos, and covered various related topics. She also provided insights into career perspectives, research experience, application procedures, types of research internship opportunities, as well as exams and study materials for post-graduation and PhD programs.

Upon the conclusion of her talk, a 30-minute interactive session followed, during which students posed questions to the speaker. Subsequently, the event was concluded.

Given the hybrid nature of the event, a total of 31 participants attended, with 7 online and 24 offline participants. Additionally, six faculty members from various departments of the college were in attendance.









